

**Gregg Township Board of Supervisors
Regular Meeting Minutes
March 12, 2020**

The regularly scheduled Board of Supervisors (BOS) meeting for Gregg Township, Centre County, was held on March 12, 2020 at 106 School Street, Suite 106, Spring Mills PA with Chair Keri Miller, Douglas Bierly and Charles Stover in attendance. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Miller called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. followed by the pledge of allegiance.
